### **PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

Known as Bowl 16, this room is used interchangeably for teaching, presenting and distance learning by way of videoconferencing. The centerpiece display is a large rear-projection screen positioned between two 61-inch plasma displays. The 90-seat classroom has 41 desktop microphones to encourage audience participation.

This room is one in a series of advanced presentation rooms at Princeton University's Woodrow Wilson School of National and International Affairs.
